These conditions of use are to ensure an equitable, safe and enjoyable experience for all users.

- Please place personal belongings in a locker or cubie before using the Larkaun Homes Squash Courts. Red Deer Polytechnic assumes no responsibility for personal belongings that are damaged, lost or stolen.
- Wearing protective eye wear when playing squash is strongly recommended.
- Participants 18 years and under must wear protective eye wear.
- Only squash must be played in the squash courts. No other racquet sports or training is allowed.
- Music with offensive language will not be tolerated in the Centre.
- No food is allowed inside the Larkaun Homes Squash Courts.
- Users must check in at the Fitness Desk before entering the court for their booking.
- Repeated failure to show up for a court booking may result in loss of booking privileges.
- Courts not in use within 15 minutes of a scheduled booking will become available for use on a first-come, first-serve basis.
 1. Please notify the Fitness staff of any no-shows.
 2. Giving less than two hours' notice of cancellation is considered a no-show.
- Patrons must wear athletic/active clothing and clean athletic footwear with non-marking soles. A t-shirt/tank top or sleeveless shirt must be always worn. When wearing sports bras/sport tops, they must be covered by a t-shirt, muscle shirt, or tank top. Revealing clothing that exposes the midriff front, buttocks, or any portion of under-garments designed to be worn as under-garments, are not authorized while working out.
- Smoking is not permitted within any Red Deer Polytechnic facility. The Gary W. Harris Canada Games Centre outdoor grounds (including pathways, sidewalks, patio areas, landscape areas, playing fields and entranceways) is designated tobacco and smoke free (inclusive of e-cigarettes). This refers to all tobacco products, including smokeless and chewing tobacco. Reference the RDP Smoking and Tobacco Policy
- Emergency Exit maps are located in the facility. Each staff member can point out their location for your reference.
- First Aid responders are not guaranteed to be on location at Red Deer Polytechnic Facilities. See RDP Staff for assistance or directly call 9-1-1 for a major emergency.
- RDP Facilities are equipped with Automated External Defibrillators (AED's). See area staff for location.
